Start: Monte do Guizo, GPS: N 37° 41' 4"; W 7° 33' 50"

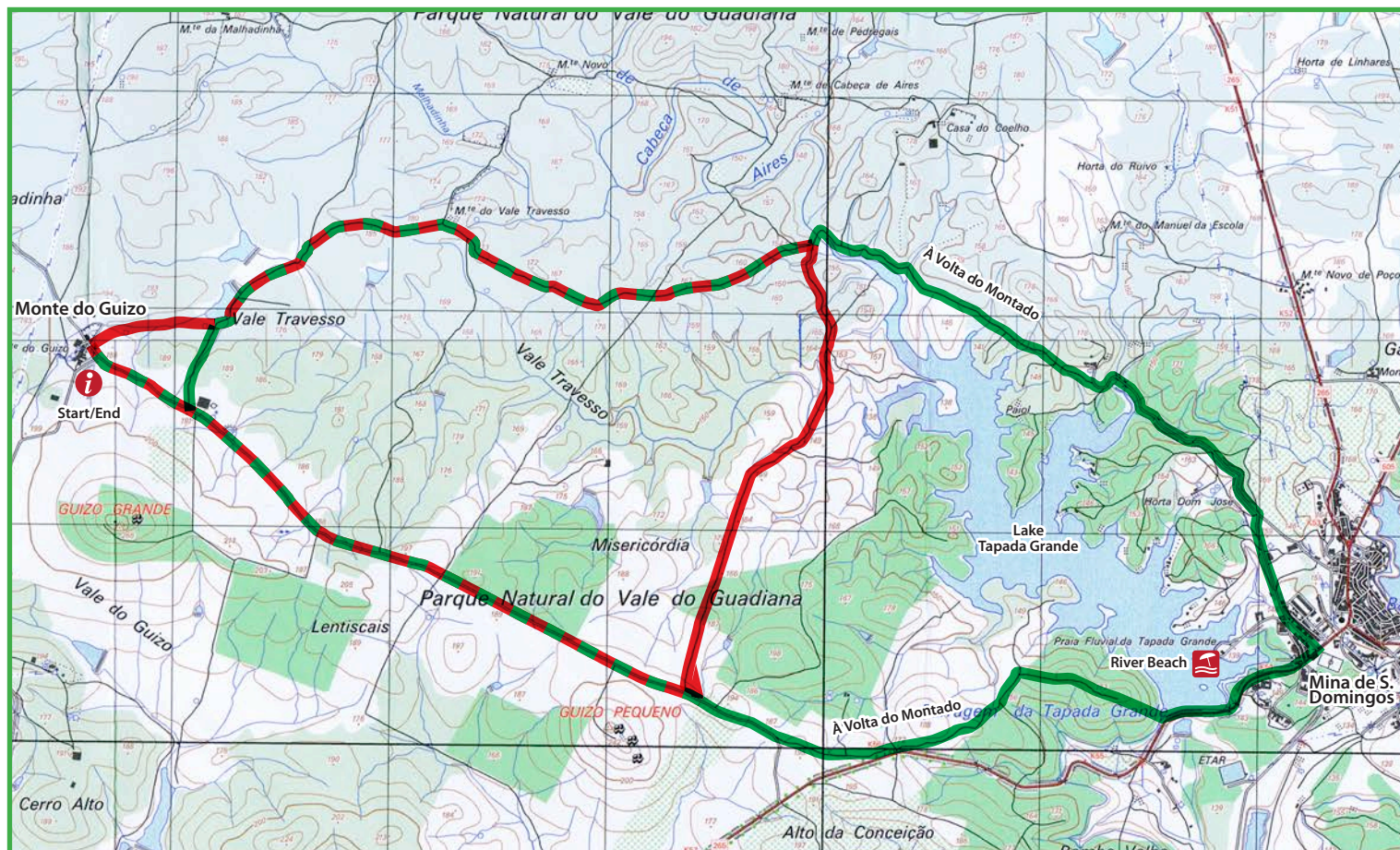
Approach: From Mertola east the EN264 towards Mina de S. Domingo. Drive into Moreanes and continue towards Serralhas. Straight on to Monte do Guizo. The last part is on a dirt track.

Zufahrt: Von Mertola aus östlich auf der EN264 Richtung Mina de S. Domingo. Fahrt in das Dorf Moreanes und weiter Richtung Serralhas. Immer geradeaus bis Monte do Guizo. Das letzte Stück auf einer Schotterstrasse.

Length/Länge: 17 km

Time/Zeit: 5h
