Between Escalda and Pulo do Lobo

Zwischen Escalda und Pulo do Lobo



WIPortugal

Start: Estrada Pulo do Lobo, GPS: N 37° 48' 54"; W 7° 38' 59"

Approach: From Mertola west on the EN122 towards Beja. After 2 km, turn right at the sign "Corte de Gafo de Cima". Continue straight around this village in the direction "Amendoeira da Serra" and "Pulo do Lobo". After 9 km, turn right following the signs "Amendoeira da Serra". In this village, follow the signs "Pulo do Lobo". Around 5 km after leaving the village, in a curve to the right, the route starts. Zufahrt: Von Mertola aus westlich auf der EN122 Richtung Beja. Nach 2 km, rechts abbiegen bei den Schildern "Corte de Gafo de Cima". Dieses Dorf umfahren in Richtung "Amendoeira da Serra" und "Pulo do Lobo". Nach 9 km, rechts abbiegen Richtung "Amendoeira da Serra". In diesem Dorf den Schildern "Pulo do Lobo" folgen. Nach etwa 5 km, in einer Rechtskurve, beginnt die Wanderung.

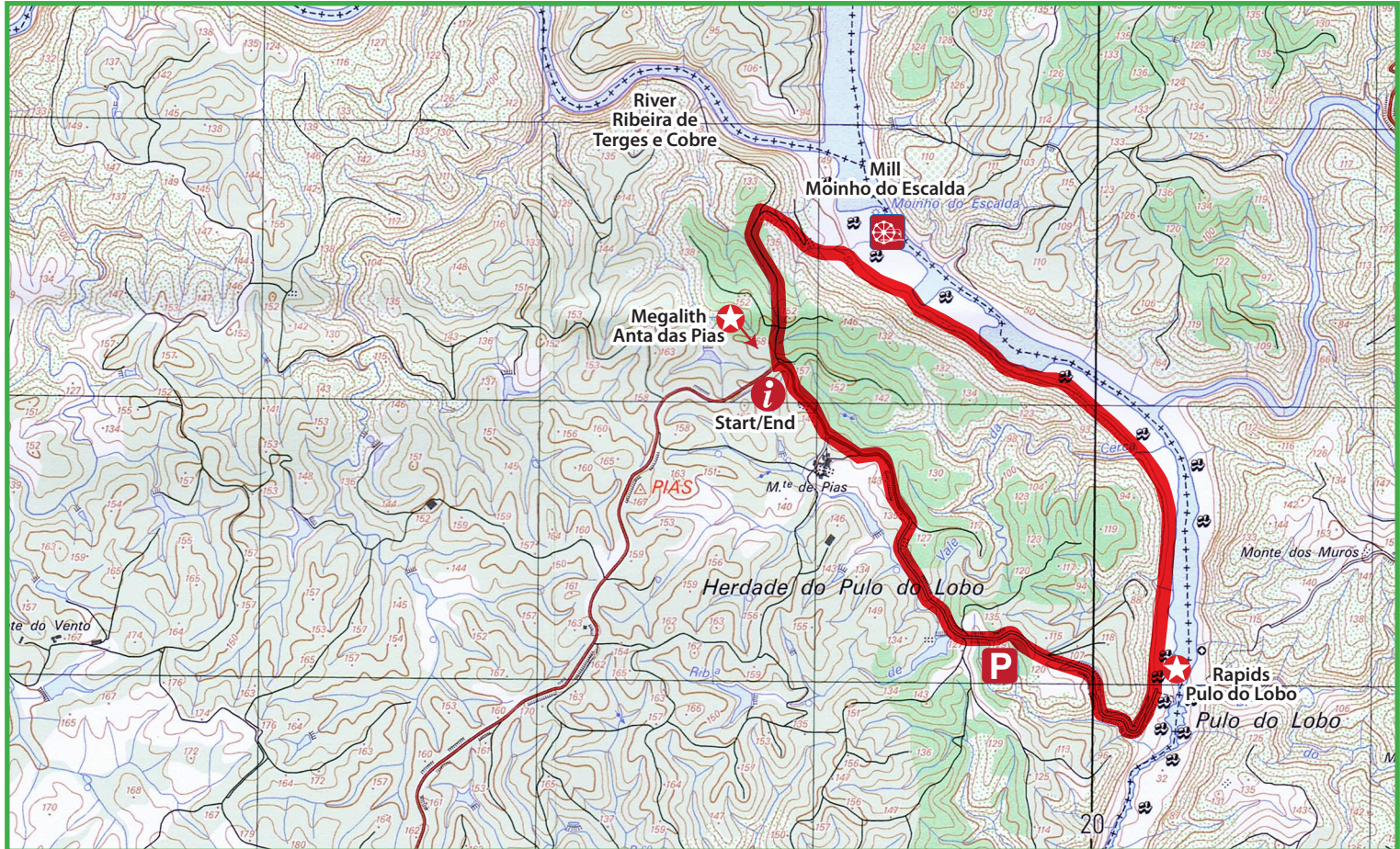

Anta das Pias: Dolmen, from around 5000-3000 B.C. / Dolmen von 5000-3000 B.C.

Moinho do Escalda: Watermill located right in the mouth of the Terges and Cobres river / Wassermühle in der Mündung des Terges und Cobres Fluss in den Guadiana.

Pulo do Lobo: (Jump of the Wolf) Here the water of Guadiana drops around 16 m. / (Sprung des Wolfes) Hier fällt der Guadiana Fluss etwa 16 m tief
